



An entrepreneurial drive by the Association Center Guélawé in partnership with the sponsored schools

The inscription of the children in the school is a responsibility; fight against the hunger also makes part of that.

The distribution of american cattlewell was fulfilling an important paper in the schooling of the children in **Burkina Faso**, which was that one of the struggle against the hunger. It's abolition influences considerably the scholastic results. To provide this lack of food help in the schools, the State burkinabé launched the initiative "Cantique endogeno": a food collection by parents who should be used for the preparation of meals at school. It works, but not in the way wanted by most of the persons in charge by the primary schools.



Following the same line against the hunger, the Association **Centre Guélawé** was offering daily bread and jam to the children of the basic school of **Loto**, thanks to private donations, specially the international ones. However, the fear of following the footsteps of the american cattlewell, the association proposed to the APE of the sponsored schools the creation of the "agricultural scholastic fields". These are agricultural areas belonging to sponsored schools, which are administered by the parents of the pupils and supervised by a committee composed by representatives of the Association **Centre Guélawé**, the school and the APE.

The goal of this dynamic is to allow to the elementary schools to be autonomous regarding the national and international subsidies, producing foods (such as millet, corns and beans), to guarantee food to the school canteen during the whole year.

The funding aims to provide the necessary resources such as agricultural equipment, the power animal to work in the fields. etc..

The funding required amounts to € 1000.
