



Mothers educators

The school of the village of **Loto** joined the mothers of the pupils under an initiative named “**Educational Mothers**”. This initiative has a double objective:

- Enable each “Educational Mother” to obtain a micro credit, with a refund of 5 % of interest, which allows them to drive small activities creators of income.
- Support the education of children in need, with the interests accrued from this initiative.

It's already started a pilot phase (with the School of **Loto** and the Association **Center Guélawé**) by granting a credit of 500 euro to 35 mothers educators who already work with small commerce.

Agricultural potentialities of the virgin plains

The project **Centre Guélawé** is the first one to do one's utmost in the exploration of the virgin plains that constitute the great riches of **Burkina Faso**.

The transformation of the plains, with the use of systems of irrigation, will allow to the local populations to develop alternative activities, like the cultivation of rice fields and gardening, during the whole year. Such activities will be a great contribute to reduce the escape of labour for the outside, allowing to the young persons to put down roots in the territory itself and, at the same time, to fight against the poverty, a phenomenon still recently in **Burkina Faso**.



Birth certificate

Each child has a right to the birth certificate. It is the first document what there contain informations on his origin: place where he was born, dates, etnia and origin of the parents. This document is also that what will allow to him the school inscription and getting other important documents like the certificate of nationality, identity card, criminal register, etc. In **Burkina Faso** this certificate costs only € 2,00, but thousands of children are still private by the right.

The founder of the Centre, **Sami Guélawé Palm**, aims at the creation of a campaign of awareness and information to the peasants, to eliminate this phenomenon and ensure that their children this right required.
